NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Rules for Championship Sailing and Board Sailing will apply for the Contender, FD, FF 65 and Pion class.

2 Entries

- 2.1 Eligible boats may be entered by completing the entry form published by their class associations before August 28, 2010.
- 2.2 Eligible competitors shall meet all ownership, class membership and boat measurement requirements as laid down in their class rules and must have paid the entry fee before becoming official competitors.
- 2.3 The entry fee is 50€ for the FD, FF 65 and Sprinta Sport class, 70€ for the Pion class and 45€ for the other classes and must be paid in cash or via pin at the Regatta Office upon arrival.
- 2.4 Late entries will be accepted, but will be charged at 10€ extra.

3 Classification

The ISAF Sailor Classification Code will apply.

4 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions are available from August 28, 2010 at www.knzrv.nl or at the Regatta Office on Friday, 8.00 – 12.00 hrs and 19.00 – 21.00 hrs and on Saturday, 08.00 hrs – 10.00 hrs.

5 Measurement requirements

- 5.1 Each yacht must present a valid measurement certificate upon registration.
Yachts and crews may be inspected during the regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee.

6 Registration and Racing Schedule

Friday September 3, 2010, from 8.00 – 12.00 hrs and from 19.00 – 21.00 hrs and

Saturday September 4, 2010 from 08.00 – 10.00 hrs: Registration

Friday September 3, 2010

12.00 hrs: 1st start of races 1-3 for Contender, FD,FF 65 and Sprinta Sport
11.00 hrs: 1st start of long distance race Pion

Saturday September 4, 2010

10.30 hrs: 1st start of races 4-6 Contender, FD,FF 65, Sprinta Sport,
Pion races 2-4
11.00 hrs: 1st start of race 1-3 other classes

Sunday September 5, 2010

10.00 hrs: 1st start of races 7-9 Contender, FD, FF 65, Sprinta Sport, Pion
races 5-6, other classes race 4-6

Last warning signal not later than 15.00 hrs.

7 Courses and Racing Areas

7.1 The course configuration will upwind-downwind or trapezium with upwind spreader buoy and possibly downwind gate.

The Contender and Flying Dutchman Class might sail a triangular course.

7.2 Courses will be laid for the expected duration of 60 minutes per race, except for the long distance race.

8 Scoring

8.1 The Low-point scoring system of appendix A will apply.
A minimum of 4 races will constitute a series. For the Pion class the scores for the long distance race are multiplied by 1.25 and cannot be discarded.
When from 5 to 8 are completed, the worst score of each yacht shall be discarded except for the J22 class.
When 9 races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

9 Prizes

9.1 There will be prizes for the first three competitors.

9.2 The winner in the Contender Class acquires the title Nederlands Klassenkampioen 2010.

9.3 The winner in the FD Class acquires the title Nederlands Klassenkampioen 2010 as well as the 'Prins Bernhard Memorial Trophy'.

9.4 The winner in the FF 65 Class acquires the title Nederlands Klassenkampioen 2010.

9.5 The winner in the Pion Class acquires the title Nederlands Kampioen 2010.

9.6 Extra prizes may be made available by the class organizations of the respective classes.

10 Launching

A crane is available on the premises of the KNZ&RV on Thursday evening from 17.00 hrs till dark, Friday from 8.00 hrs till dark, Saturday morning from 8.00 hrs and on Sunday after the races.

Boats wishing to be craned earlier on Thursday should contact the Harbour Masters, + 31 294 261450.

11 Haul out restrictions

Yachts, except for Contender and FD, may not be hauled during the regatta after the first race and must be moored at the assigned locations. Hauling requires prior written permission of the Race Committee.

12 Disclaimer of liability

All parties involved in the organization the running of the Regatta shall not accept any liability for any accident, injury damage or loss of personal property or otherwise to yachts, third parties and participants, before, during or after the regatta.

13 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1000.000 per event or the equivalent.

14 Social

A sailors dinner will be organized on Saturday evening at the Clubhouse of the KNZ&RV. Tickets are available at registration and will be charged separately.

15 Camping

Limited accommodation is available for campers and tents. The Harbour Masters should be contacted before hand, + 31 294 261450.
